

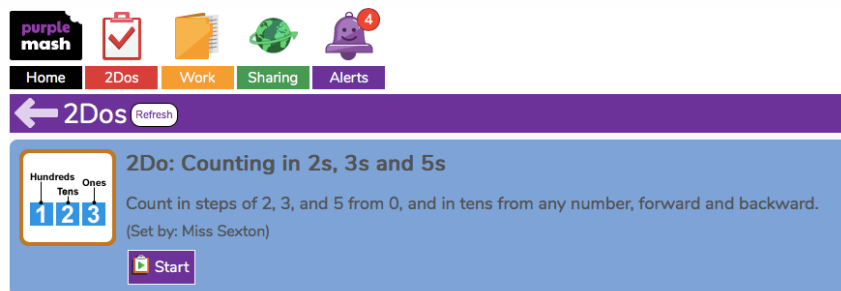

Dear Parents and Carers,

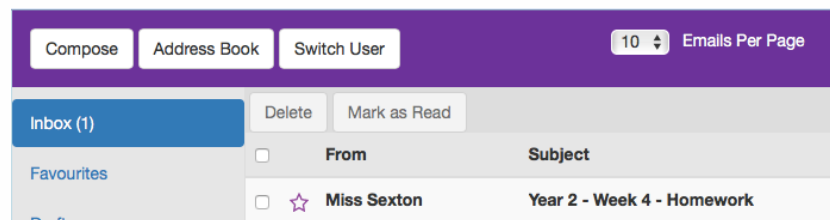

Alternatively, English and Maths homework will be sent via 2Email, where your child can reply with their completed homework to their class teacher. This week your child will receive a 2Email and they have to reply to their class teacher by Wednesday next week. It will look a little like this:

Please note that we are currently having some technical difficulties with Rising Stars, so once the problems are solved your child will receive their log in details. Thank you for your patience.
