

Monday 19th November 2018

Dear Parents and Guardians,

As you are probably aware, our trip to Bristol Aquarium is upon us! As requested, here is some information outlining the trip.

To make the most of our time there, we will need all the children in school, no later than 8.45 am on Wednesday 21st November 2018. Children will need to come up to their classrooms to be registered. The coach will be picking us up approximately 9.15 am. We plan to leave Bristol Aquarium at 2.15pm for a return to school at approximately 3.30. Children will be taken to their classrooms to be registered before being collected. If this is any later, a text will be sent out via the office.

You will need:

- School uniform- this is for easy identification whilst we are there.
- A suitable and nutritious packed lunch with snack (we are gone for a long time, snacks are not provided so they will need to come with these)
- Clearly labelled bottle, 2 bottles of **water**- it is a long day so children will need to be kept hydrated (Fizzy pop is not accepted).
- A rucksack or back pack to carry all their lunch (They will be carrying it all day, plastic bags tend to rip.)
- Travel sick tablets (One **taken 20 minutes before school** and one in a clearly labelled envelope for the return journey).
- Optional £5 to be spent in the shop (This will be children's responsibility, adults will not be carrying children's money).

Children will have the opportunity to visit the gift shop, we are limiting the money to £5 per child that should be carried by the child at all times (As previously mentioned, staff are not allowed to carry the money on behalf of the child or to deal with change or purchasing).

Please be aware, if your child does suffer from travel sickness please ensure they are given a travel sickness tablet 20 minutes before school as if your child is unwell, there will be nowhere at Bristol Aquarium for them to be changed if they are unwell on the coach. Please ensure you put a second travel sickness tablet in their bag for the return journey home and inform them of this. Teachers will ensure children take them before we leave Bristol.
