Key Vocabulary and Definitions:

Diagonal line	It is made out of a straight line that's set at an angle instead of straight up or across.
Horizontal line	It is a straight line that is drawn from left to right or right to left.
Mosaic	It is a pattern or image made of small regular or irregular pieces of coloured stone, glass or ceramic, held in place by plaster/mortar, and covering a surface.
Shadow puppet	They are figures that are placed between a light and a screen. Moving them creates the illusion of moving images on the screen.
To expand	To become or make larger or more extensive.
Sculpture	It is an artistic form in which hard or plastic materials are worked into three-dimensional art objects.

Teaching Sequence

1. To draw details of an insect using pencils and crayons.
2. To expand an image of an insect and create a mosaic
3. To make a 3 D model
4. To create a shadow puppet drawing a large insect picture on dark paper.
