Computing – Information Technology

We will be looking at...

...save and retrieve files on the school network (PupilShare). ...explore new media to extend what they can achieve. ...combine a mixture of text, graphics and sound to share their ideas and learning. ...use appropriate keyboard commands to amend text on their device....evaluate their work and improve its effectiveness....say what kind of information they could use to help them investigate a question. ...talk about the different ways they use technology to collect information, including a camera, microscope or sound recorder and do this independently. ...talk about the different ways in which information can be shown.

Maths

Time – estimation... calculate time taken... comparing times.

Shape – angles as features and turns... right angles... quarter turns... horizontal and vertical lines... parallel and perpendicular lines... drawing and measuring 2D and 3D shapes with a rules and modelling materials.

Mass and Capacity – measure and compare mass... add and subtract mass... measure/compare capacity... add and subtract capacity.
